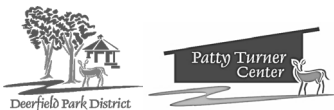

The West Deerfield Township Accessibility Grant for disabled residents is aimed at improving quality of life through increased access to the community. Grants up to \$1000 per household per year may be awarded. Expenses which may qualify for this program include things like home modifications, mobility equipment, adaptive communication devices, some therapies, etc. Older adults are encouraged to apply!! You may be entitled to a big reduction in your Secretary of State License Plate renewal sticker and get the RTA Senior Rides FREE card! If you're already part of the program, it is suggested you renew at the first opportunity, which is three months prior to expiration. The application is good for two years. ALL applications and documentation must be submitted online; no paper forms exist. You can do it yourself at the Illinois Department on Aging's website. Residents of Deerfield, West Deerfield Township, and PTC members may make an appointment with Margie and she will do it for you!! Also, the Village of Deerfield offers resident who are seniors LIHEAP recipients (monthly income <\$1508 for individuals) the village sticker for just \$1.
