In accordance with state and local guidelines, the PTC will re-open providing virtual, in-person programming, and curbside lending closet services by appointment only.

Registration

In order to participate in any in-person program, advanced registration is required. Please no walk-ins or general visitation.

PTC Facility Guidelines

During this time, the PTC will be following the below guidelines to ensure your safety and well-being.

- Scheduled programs will be offered to members of the PTC either virtually by ZOOM or in-person by instructor.
- All participants will be required to pre-register for programs by mail, in-person, or phone in advance.
- A maximum of up to (10) members will be allowed to participate in each scheduled in-person program.
- All members will be required to complete a brief health screening on the day of attendance.
- All members will be required to wear masks and practice 6-feet social distancing while on site.
- Weekly Men's Club Lectures will continue to be presented via Zoom (no registration required).
- Social Services and Lending Closet Services will be available by appointment only.
- No podiatry or massage services will be offered.
- No card groups, evening classes, or rentals will be offered.
- No food or beverages will be allowed.
- All rooms and furniture utilized throughout the day will be properly disinfected.

Benefit Access Application

For a discount on your license plate renewal sticker or an RTA Senior Rides Free Card, one must first complete a Benefit Access Application found on the Illinois Department on Aging website. To be eligible, one must be 65 years old or disabled AND have an annual income <\$33,562 (single) \$44,533 (couple). This financial threshold was recently raised, allowing wider eligibility. Approved applications are good for two years. If you need to assistance to apply or renew, please contact Margie at PTC.
