

**MINUTES FINANCE MEETING BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS**      **November 18, 2021**

The Finance Meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners was called to order by President Patinkin at 7:00 p.m. in the Jewett Park Community Center. The Secretary called the roll and the following were:

and there was a quorum in attendance. Also present was Jeff Nehila, Jeff Harvey, Laura McCarty, Jay Zahn, Tony Korzyniewski, Jason Mannina, staff members.

Commissioners proceeded to review financial materials relative to the meeting.

Treasurer Cohen asked about the Deerspring water line break. Staff responded that there was a water main break near the concession area and fire hydrant. The village repaired and lifted the main.

Treasurer Cohen asked if there were any sign shops in Deerfield. Staff responded that there are no known shops in town.

Commissioner Brown asked about the \$8,500 resurfacing and repair work to the tennis courts. Staff responded that this is for the courts at Deerspring. Half of the job was completed and will be finished in the spring. The courts are lined for tennis and pickleball.

Commissioner Brown asked about the \$1,200 repair at SRC. Staff responded that it was for the boilers.

Commissioner Brown asked about the \$5,200 camera replacement at SRC. Staff responded that this is part of planned maintenance and upgrades.

Commissioner Serota asked about Legal Services acronyms used. Director Nehila commented that Klein, Thorpe and Jenkins handle our tax appeals and objections. President Patinkin reviewed some of the commonly used acronyms.

President Patinkin asked about the health insurance for a former employee. Staff responded that it is a refund for prepayment of the monthly insurance premium from IMRF as the former employee will not be continuing on our health care plan.

President Patinkin stated that the lights at Jewett Park have been left on many nights. Staff will remind Affiliates to turn off the lights when they are finished.

President Patinkin asked about the fence gate at Wilmot. Staff responded that we paid for the fence gate so we could have vehicle access to put wood chips in the playground.

President Patinkin asked about the water bills at Brickyards and Clavey. Staff responded that those bills are for August and September when we were still doing a lot of irrigating of the fields.

President Patinkin asked when the whirlpool at SRC would be repaired and reopened. Staff responded that the whirlpool should be reopening tomorrow, November 19.

President Patinkin asked what happened to the Tracey Beth Rumick Playground sign. Staff responded that it was vandalized, and we will be getting a new sign.

Director Nehila reported that the Caruso Auditorium renovation bid opening will be held on November 30.
