Vice-President Cohen asked what the rent is per month at 921 Wilmot and how much the district budgets for expenses. Staff responded that we receive \$2,500 per month in rent and budget \$2,000 for contractual services and \$1,000 for materials and supplies.

Vice-President Cohen asked about the fee paid to Riverwoods for the golf course. Staff responded that it is an annual expense based on revenues the course makes.

President Caron asked about the electric charges at Maplewood. Staff responded that it is for running a space heater inside the pipe chase to prevent frozen pipes.
