Medicare Open Enrollment

October 15th – December 7th

It's Almost Here!

Time to review your Drug Plan or Advantage Plan! Plans change and your needs change: Make sure you have the coverage that works best for you and at the best price! Any changes made become effective on January 1. You can do it yourself using the Medicare.gov Plan Finder- or you can visit a PTC SHIP counselor who will do it for you! In-person and Zoom visits will be offered. **We will begin booking appointments on Monday, September 26th.** Call Marcella at our front desk. Don't delay as every year demand exceeds our supply.

**If you are unable to get an appointment you can always call 1-800-MEDICARE and a phone agent will assist you.*

Savings via Benefit Access

If you are age 65+ (or totally disabled) AND have income less than \$33,562 (single) or \$44,533 (couple), you can apply for the Illinois Benefit Access Program that will **SAVE MONEY** on your **license plate** renewal sticker and demonstrates your eligibility for the **Senior RIDES FREE transit card!** All applications must be submitted online. You can do it yourself on the Illinois Department on Aging's website. PTC members can also make an appointment with Margie for assistance too!

SHIP counselors at the PTC are members of our community who have been screened, trained, and certified as Medicare experts. They are volunteers who provide unbiased confidential counseling to help Medicare beneficiaries make informed decisions in regard to choosing and using benefits.
