

TREE

Cost: \$500

Includes an engraved nameplate "In Honor of..." or "In Memory of..." (displayed on the wall in the main entrance of Jewett Park Community Center). Each donor works with our on staff horticulturist for available tree and park placement. All trees are carefully chosen, healthy specimens, grown in selected nurseries in the area. Planting occurs in the Spring and Fall and is dependent on the type of tree chosen.

TREE OPTIONS

- Evergreen, Pine, Spruce, Fir (Dark green, long needled pyramidal pine; 50' at maturity.)
- Redbud (Flowering tree with small, budlike, pink flowers; 20-30' at maturity)
- Maple (symmetrical tree with lustrous dark foliage; 45'-70' at maturity.)
- Oak (spring planting only. Round, densely branched with deep green foliage; 50' at maturity.)
- Linden (Oval form with straight trunk, deep green foliage with fragrant flowers in spring; 60-70' at maturity.)
- Kentucky Coffee (Many distinctive, unique features, including unusual bark and binately compound leaves. Leaf color is dark bluish-green in the summer and yellow in the fall; 65' tall x 50' wide at maturity.)
- Ohio Buckeye (Palmate leaves are dark green that turn yellowish-orange in the fall. Flowers are white clusters in the spring. Has a rounded shape that is 40' tall x 40' wide at maturity.)

PARK BENCH

Inquire for specific park availability for placement of new benches and for existing bench availability for plaque only placement.

Cost: \$2,500

Includes purchase of new bench, option of bench placement and an engraved plague on bench. Plague size is 2" x 12". Maximum of 3 lines, 100-150 characters total.

Cost: \$600

Includes engraved plague on existing bench. Plague size is 2" x 12". Maximum of 3 lines, 100-150 characters total.

MVP DONOR WALL

Cost: \$50

Engraved nameplate on plague at Sachs Recreation Center. Max of 3 lines, 22 characters/space per line.

ENGRAVED DOG BONE

Cost: \$50

Available at Jaycee Dog Park/Exercise Area.
